

Privacy Policy

We would like to inform you that we process your personal data - detailed information can be found below:

1. The Administrator of your personal data is The Centre for Theoretical Physics of the Polish Academy of Sciences with its headquarters in Warsaw, Al. Lotników 32/46, 02-668 Warszawa, NIP:525-000-92-81, REGON:000844815.
2. The administrator has appointed a Data Protection Inspector supervising the correctness of personal data processing, who can be contacted via e-mail: iod@cft.edu.pl
3. Your personal data will be processed based on the Article 6 paragraph 1 of the general regulation on the protection of personal data RODO and the CFT Data Protection Policy in order to:
 - 1) conclusion and performance of the contract for the services of the Center for Theoretical Physics, - because the processing is necessary to perform the contract (Article 6 paragraph 1 (b) of the RODO >GDPR<);
 - 2) implementation of scientific and research activities - because processing is necessary for the performance of the contract (Article 6 paragraph 1 (b) of the RODO >GDPR<)
 - 3) establish, investigate or defend against claims related to the concluded contract or the processing of your personal data - because processing is necessary to fulfill a legally legitimate interest (Article 6.1.1 f of the RODO), which is the possibility to establish, investigate or defend against claims;
 - 4) fulfillment of legal obligations imposed on us under applicable law - because the processing in this case is necessary to fulfill the legal requirements to which we are subject (Article 6 (1) (c) of the GDPR)
4. Providing personal data is voluntary, however, necessary to achieve the purposes for which they were collected;
5. The data will not be made available to the third parties, except for cases provided for by law, entities providing accounting, IT, marketing, communication and analytics, legal and debt collection services, scientific and research units, subcontractors and other entities with whom we cooperate.
6. Personal data will be stored for the purpose of:
 - 1) performance of the contract until the statute of limitations,
 - 2) fulfillment of legal obligations imposed on us - until the expiration of data storage obligations resulting from legal provisions;
 - 3) establish, an investigation or a defend against legal claims - until the limitation of claims.
7. You have the right to access your personal data and the right to correct, delete, limit processing, the right to transfer data, the right to appeal, the right to withdraw consent at any time;
8. You have the right to lodge a complaint to the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection;

9. Your data will not be processed in an automated manner and will not be profiled.
